Are all relevant sources cited in the literature review?

In the literature review, do the author(s) present the latest scientific findings?

Are the research question(s) and hypothesis(es) formulated based on the studies presented in the literature review?

Are the research question(s) relevant?

Are the methods presented in a clear and punctual way?

Are the methods used appropriate to answer the research problem?

What is the level of novelty of the results?

Is the conclusion chapter clear in presenting the conclusions?

In the conclusion/summary chapter, do the author(s) reflect on the differences and/or similarities between their own research and the results of the cited studies?


Are the references appropriate?

Are the studies in the reference list found in the text?


